Journalism and Communication Education TWG Annual Activity Report 2014

The TWG was established in February 2014 and organised its first Business meeting on November 13 at the ECREA ECC 2014 conference in Lisbon. At the Business meeting, the management team that initiated the founding of the TWG (Chair: Michael Harnischmacher (Universität Trier), Vice Chairs Harmen Groenhart (Fontys University of Applied Sciences, Tilburg) and Carlos Barrera del Barrio (Universidad de Navarra)) has been confirmed.
